

Recommendations and Warranty Policy Gro-Zone Temporary Structures

Congratulations on the purchase of your new **Gro-Zone** Structure. These structures offer a great retail-merchandising vehicle for your lawn and garden center supplies or any merchandise you would like to display under temporary shelter. The following information is intended for you and your customer's safety and protection.

Gro-Zone structures are intended for use as temporary structures and precautions must be taken to avoid damage to your new unit **Gro-Zone** temporary structures are not designed to withstand high wind or snow loads. All owners must take necessary action to minimize the possibility of damage during high wind, snow or heavy rain conditions. The following table contains recommendations for minimizing product and property damage possibilities:

Recommendations	Methods
<p>Weight the structures down with a minimum of 3,250 pounds of ballast for each 24 ft x 12 ft section of structure. Extra weight is needed for winds in excess of 40 MPH.</p> <p>Example: 24 x 24 foot unit requires: 24 divided by 12 = 2 2 x 3,250 lbs=6,500 lbs ballast required</p>	<p>Use a combination of 2 x 4 wooden boards placed parallel across base plates and concrete blocks, sand bags, or appropriate ballast on top of the boards to achieve the desired weight.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">or</p> <p>Use water filled drums and secure to frame fittings with rope or chain.</p>
<p>Remove the fabric coverage to eliminate the possibility of water or snow build up on the roof</p> <p>Water and snow may collect and cover or frame damage could occur if weather conditions are conducive.</p>	<p>Remove cover and store in safe place. An alternative is to remove water or snow by applying pressure to the underside of the cover to alleviate water or snow build up.</p> <p>Water and snow may collect and cover or frame damage could occur if weather conditions are conducive.</p>
